#### WELCOME (15 minutes)

(If there are first-time guests, begin with a round of introduction and warmly welcome the new visitors.)

## 2. Things in common

#### WORD (45 minutes)

**Preacher:** Rev. Daniel Khong **Scripture Passage:** Philippians 2:5-8 (NIVUK) **Sermon Title**: Order in God's house

#### **Introduction**

To function effectively as God's community, we must learn to submit to one another, especially to God's appointed leaders. Philippians 2:5 instructs us: "**In your relationships with one another**, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus." Just as Jesus set the example by submitting to His Father, our submission to one another within God's community and to God's authority reveals three qualities:

- 1. Our Obedience
- 2. Our Surrender
- 3. Our Humility

# **Discovery and Understanding Questions:**

# Q1. Why is obedience important in our submission to God? How did Jesus demonstrate His submission through obedience?

**A1.** Submission to God's authority means recognising His sovereignty. Obedience is an essential aspect of submission. Jesus' ultimate sacrifice, demonstrated through His obedience to death, reveals the depth of His love for God and His commitment to fulfilling His divine purpose. His example highlights the significance of obedience in our lives as we strive to follow Christ. Jesus demonstrated His submission by becoming obedient to the point of death – even death on a cross.

# Q2. Why is submission a test of surrender and humility?

**A2.** Submission, a fundamental biblical concept, signifies the voluntary act of surrendering one's will, rights, and authority to a higher power, often in the context of God's authority or human relationships. It requires humility, as one must set aside personal desires and ego. Jesus exemplified this surrender and humility by willingly giving up His divine rights and taking the form of a servant. He humbled Himself by sacrificing His life on a cross for our sake.
